All Adopted Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action is listed to the right of the title. Committee Reports and Floor Action are abbreviated as follows:

Committee Amendment "A" (H-992) redrafted the eminent domain provisions to limit the commissioners' eminent domain authority to taking real estate within the City of Portland needed for the new jail facility and required the right of eminent domain to be exercised within one year of the bill's effective date.

# **SUMMARY**

LD 2387 proposed to transfer authority over the Cumberland County jail from the sheriff to the Cumberland County Commissioners. The LD also created a Cumberland County Corrections Department, headed by a professional jail administrator appointed by the county commissioners.

Committee Amendment "A" (H-1078) replaced the LD and clarifies the county commissioners' authority (in every county) to approve or disapprove the appointment, discipline or dismissal of a jail administrator appointed by the sheriff.

# SUMMARY

LD 2392 is one of 8 bills implementing the recommendations of the Commission on Maine's Future. The bill requires that the Office of Comprehensive Land Use Planning submit a 4-year work plan and budget to the Governor by December 31, 1990, requires that the Maine Science and Technology Commission develop a long rage strategy plan, requires the University of Maine System to propose a curriculum for a land use planning degree, directs the Department of Conservation to prepare a comprehensive strategy to foster positive communications between landowners and recreational land users, directs the Governor to prepare a proposal for consolidating agency efforts in acquiring land for outdoor use, and directs the Governor to develop a proposal for an educational program about the State.

### **SUMMARY**

LD 2400 is one of 8 bills implementing the recommendations of the Commission on Maine's Future. This bill directs that all state entities, including Legislative Committees and staff offices, Executive

department agencies and judicial agencies, prepare and submit to the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis an annual strategic plan which coordinates the entity's daily, short-term and long term activities with the "Maine Vision", as outlined in the final report of the Commission on Maine's Future.
