This bill clarifies that the Commission on Biotechnology and Genetic Engineering has authority over both the products and the waste products of biotechnology and genetic engineering research, development and production.

SUMMARY

The bill permits the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources greater access to the records of persons receiving blueberry shipments for the purpose of ascertaining compliance with blueberry theft laws. The bill ensures that potentially sensitive business information available to the department or the Maine Blueberry Commission is kept confidential and is protected from the freedom of access laws.

SUMMARY

This bill, which was not referred to a committee, would have extended permission for any group or individual to use live animals in games if the animal's actions did not deviate from their natural behavior. Under current law only educational and cultural institutions or nonprofit service organizations may use live animals in games.
