All Adopted Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action is listed to the right of the title. Committee Reports and Floor Action are abbreviated as follows:

LD 2469 An Act Authorizing a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$20,250,000 for Construction, Planning, Purchasing and Renovation of Correctional Facilities (Reported Pursuant to Joint Order, HP1483; Majority Report)

SUMMARY

This bill was reported out by the Committee pursuant to joint order. The bill represents the majority report of the Committee regarding a general fund bond issue for correctional facilities. (See LD 2470). The bill authorizes a bond issue of \$20,250,000 for 100 new maximum-security beds in So. Warren, 50 community beds in Southern Maine, 2 restitution centers in Penobscot and Androscoggin Counties, 50 minimum-security beds at Downeast Correctional Center, a women's pre-release center in Hallowell and feasibility studies. The bill requires ratification by state-wide referendum.

Senate Amendment "A" adds a fiscal note to the bill.

LD 2470 An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount DIED WITHOUT of \$20,250,000 for Construction, Planning, Purchasing and ACTION Renovation of Correctional Facilities (Reported Pursuant to Joint Order, HP1483; Minority Report)

SPONSOR(S) COMMITTEE REPORT AMENDMENTS ADOPTED

SUMMARY

This bill was reported out by the Committee pursuant to joint order. The bill represents the minority report of the Committee regarding a general fund bond issue for correctional facilities (see LD 2469). For the same amount of money, it would authorize 224 medium-security beds instead of the majority report's 100 maximum-security beds.
