#### **SUMMARY**

This bill established the Sagadahoc County Budget Advisory Committee to review the budget estimate and make recommendations to the Sagadahoc County commissioners.

In the original bill, the Sagadahoc County Budget Advisory Committee was comprised of elected municipal officials only. Committee Amendment "A" changed the composition of the committee to include 6 elected municipal officials and 3 representatives of the general public. It also added an emergency preamble, emergency clause and a sunset provision to the bill.

House Amendment "A" retained all of the substantive provisions of the committee amendment but reorganized the statutory units so that the law may be better understood and implemented.

#### **SUMMARY**

This constitutional resolution proposed a referendum to amend the Constitution to permit citizen recall of elected officials for misfeasance, malfeasance or violation of oath while in office upon the petition of qualified voters equal to 35% of the total number of votes cast for that office in the preceding election. LD 1964 became a companion piece of legislation to this bill.
