SUMMARY

In 1989 the Legislature enacted legislation to ensure that a certain percentage of new housing constructed with public funds would be accessible to persons with physical disabilities. This bill clarifies that this particular requirement does not apply to units of housing that existed prior to October 1, 1988 that are remodeled, renovated or enlarged after that date.

SUMMARY

The bill corrects an error resulting from the recodification of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30 as Title 30-A. Language designating the director of the Maine State Housing Authority as the official responsible for certifying that housing-related bonds meet the bond volume requirements of the federal Internal Revenue Code was unintentionally dropped when Title 30-A was enacted. This bill puts the old language back in statute.
