This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature. The volume is organized alphabetically by committee; within each committee, the summaries are arranged by LD number. A subject index is provided at the beginning of each committee's summaries.

The committee report or reports, the prime sponsor for each bill and the lead co-sponsor in each house if one has been designated are listed below each bill title. All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number, together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various types of final action are abbreviated as follows:

This bill requires the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of the Budget to monitor federal legislation to determine the cost of implementing that legislation at local and state levels.

#### **SUMMARY**

This bill allows Great Diamond Island to separate from the City of Portland and to incorporate as a village corporation within the Town of Long Island. The amendment, which did not pass, incorporated LD 1408 with LD 1421 and LD 1425 into one bill. The amendment allows Great Diamond Island, Cushings Island and Little Diamond Island the right to vote to secede from the City of Portland and join the town of Long Island.

#### SUMMARY

Subject to referenda, this bill authorizes the separation of Cushings Island from the City of Portland and allows the creation of the Cushings Island Village Corporation in the Town of Long Island. See LD 1408.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-569) establishes a procedure and standards for secession. The amendment was ruled not germane to the bill. See LD 2006.
