SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION BEFORE THE JOINT STANDING COMMITTEES

AUGUST 1995

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees of the Maine Legislature. The volume is organized alphabetically by committee; within each committee, the summaries are arranged by LD number. A subject index is provided at the beginning of each committee's summaries. The publication, <u>History and Final Disposition of Legislative Documents</u>, is helpful in determining to which committee any particular bill was referred.

In this document, the committee report or reports, the prime sponsor for each bill and the lead co-sponsor in each house if one has been designated are listed below each bill title. All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number, together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various categories of final action are abbreviated as follows:

An Act to Promote Fairness and Due Process within Collegiate Athletics in the State

SUMMARY

This bill regulates collegiate athletic associations by establishing procedures to be followed when the association commences an investigation of a student or employee of an institution of higher learning. The procedures created by this bill ensure that the investigatory process by the association is fair to the affected individuals by establishing a standard of evidence to be used, by allowing the subject of the investigation to have counsel present at hearings and to interrogate and cross-examine witnesses, and by requiring that hearings be subject to the Maine Rules of Evidence. This bill sets a statute of limitations and establishes penalties.

SUMMARY

This bill grants authority to the Research Institute for Semiological Mathematics to confer the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Semiological Mathematics.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-31) changes the name of the Research Institute for Semiological Mathematics to the Research Institute for Mathematics. The new name conforms to the name recommended by the State Board of Education in recommending to the Legislature that the institute be granted initial authorization to award the degree of Doctor of Philosophy.
