SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION BEFORE THE JOINT STANDING COMMITTEES

AUGUST 1995

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees of the Maine Legislature. The volume is organized alphabetically by committee; within each committee, the summaries are arranged by LD number. A subject index is provided at the beginning of each committee's summaries. The publication, <u>History and Final Disposition of Legislative Documents</u>, is helpful in determining to which committee any particular bill was referred.

In this document, the committee report or reports, the prime sponsor for each bill and the lead co-sponsor in each house if one has been designated are listed below each bill title. All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number, together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various categories of final action are abbreviated as follows:

An Act to Restrict the Taking of Eels Less than 6 Inches in **Length from Maine Coastal Waters**

SUMMARY

This hill proposes to regulate the taking of eels by making it illegal to possess an eel that is less than 6 inches in length. The committee voted to carry the bill over to the Second Regular Session of the 117th Legislature. The committee requested the Department of Marine Resources develop a management plan for Maine's eel fishery and present to the committee a report on its plan and any recommended legislation by January 15, 1996.

SUMMARY

The bill would have appropriated funds to partially offset the operating costs of the Beals Island Regional Shellfish Hatchery.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-48) replaced the original bill. It would have appropriated grants of \$15,000 in fiscal year 1995-96 and \$15,000 in fiscal year 1996-97 to support the hatching and raising of seed clams at the Beals Island Regional Shellfish Hatchery.

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" TO COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-374) alters the committee amendment by appropriating a grant of \$15,000 in fiscal year 1995-96 to the Beals Island Regional Shellfish Hatchery and eliminating the grant for fiscal year 1996-97 that had been included in Committee amendment "A".

SUMMARY

The bill provides that the only penalty for the violation of certain provisions of a municipal shellfish conservation ordinance be a fine imposed according to the laws authorizing municipal shellfish conservation programs. Its purpose is to prevent a court from imposing a penalty other than a fine, such as community service.
