SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION BEFORE THE JOINT STANDING COMMITTEES

AUGUST 1995

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees of the Maine Legislature. The volume is organized alphabetically by committee; within each committee, the summaries are arranged by LD number. A subject index is provided at the beginning of each committee's summaries. The publication, <u>History and Final Disposition of Legislative Documents</u>, is helpful in determining to which committee any particular bill was referred.

In this document, the committee report or reports, the prime sponsor for each bill and the lead co-sponsor in each house if one has been designated are listed below each bill title. All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number, together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various categories of final action are abbreviated as follows:

SUMMARY

This bill clarifies that the budget for municipal services in the unorganized territory of Somerset County is included under the jurisdiction of the Somerset County Budget Committee. The bill also provides that, beginning in 1996, the Somerset County legislative delegation shall select the members of the delegation to serve on the Somerset County Budget Committee by December 1st every other year.

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" (S-300) strikes from the bill provisions relating to approval of the municipal services budget for unorganized territories in Somerset County.

SUMMARY

Part A of this bill authorizes the incorporation of the Town of Biddeford Pool if the legal residents of Biddeford Pool approve, by referendum, separation from the City of Biddeford and incorporation as a separate town.

Part B of this bill requires the parties to negotiate matters of duties and responsibilities in advance of a vote approving the question presented at the referendum election. If the parties fail to agree in a timely fashion, the matters are subject to binding arbitration.
