SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION BEFORE THE JOINT STANDING COMMITTEES

AUGUST 1995

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees of the Maine Legislature. The volume is organized alphabetically by committee; within each committee, the summaries are arranged by LD number. A subject index is provided at the beginning of each committee's summaries. The publication, <u>History and Final Disposition of Legislative Documents</u>, is helpful in determining to which committee any particular bill was referred.

In this document, the committee report or reports, the prime sponsor for each bill and the lead co-sponsor in each house if one has been designated are listed below each bill title. All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number, together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various categories of final action are abbreviated as follows:

SUMMARY

This bill requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission to develop a recovery plan prior to the introduction or reintroduction of an endangered or threatened species in the State. The introduction or reintroduction of that species must be conducted in accordance with that recovery plan and may not begin until 90 days after the commissioner has conducted a public hearing on that plan and submitted a copy of that plan to the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

SUMMARY

This bill would have abolished the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission and reassigned its responsibilities to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-607) replaces the bill. The amendment abolishes the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission and in its place establishes the Atlantic Salmon Authority. The Atlantic Salmon Authority is governed by an 8-member board consisting of 4 public members representing various geographical regions of the State, one member from the Passamaquoddy Tribe, one member from the Penobscot Nation, the
