LD 1887 Resolve, To Improve Air Quality and Ventilation in Newly Constructed Schools

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Resolve 2025, chapter 56 amends Resolve 2021, chapter 114, which required the Department of Education to amend its school construction and siting and basic approval standards rules to require standards governing air quality and ventilation for all public schools. Instead, Resolve 2025, chapter 56 requires the department to amend its rules to require those standards for only newly constructed public schools.
