- Your default password is the last four digits of your barcode.
- You can change your password after you log in.
- If you forget your password, click 'I forgot my password' or contact the circulation desk to have it reset to the default.

My Bookshelf Bookmarks

After you're logged in you can:

- Change your password, update your e-mail address, and choose your preferred pickup location.
- See what you have checked out, renew books, and place holds.
- Bookmark items for later, create lists to organize your bookmarks, and save searches.
- Save your Reading History. If you decide to turn this on, please note:
 - Your reading history only visible to you from within Vega.
 - The library can only see what you currently have checked out and what you are waiting for (holds) in our system.
 - The library can't turn your reading history on for you. If you want to maintain it, you have to turn it on from within Vega.
